

“Not Just on Sunday!”

Galatians 2

We went there because of those who pretended to be followers and had sneaked in among us as spies. They had come to take away the freedom that Christ Jesus had given us, and they were trying to make us their slaves. But we wanted you to have the true message. That's why we didn't give in to them, not even for a second. (v.4-5)

Some of them were supposed to be important leaders, but I didn't care who they were. God doesn't have any favorites! None of these so-called special leaders added anything to my message. (v.6)





THREE DISTINCT MARKS OF THOSE WHO ARE CRUCIFIED WITH CHRIST


- 1. They are facing only one direction.**
