
THE LORD'S PRAYER



- (v.26) “So in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith,*
- (v.27) for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.*
- (v.28) There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus.”*




