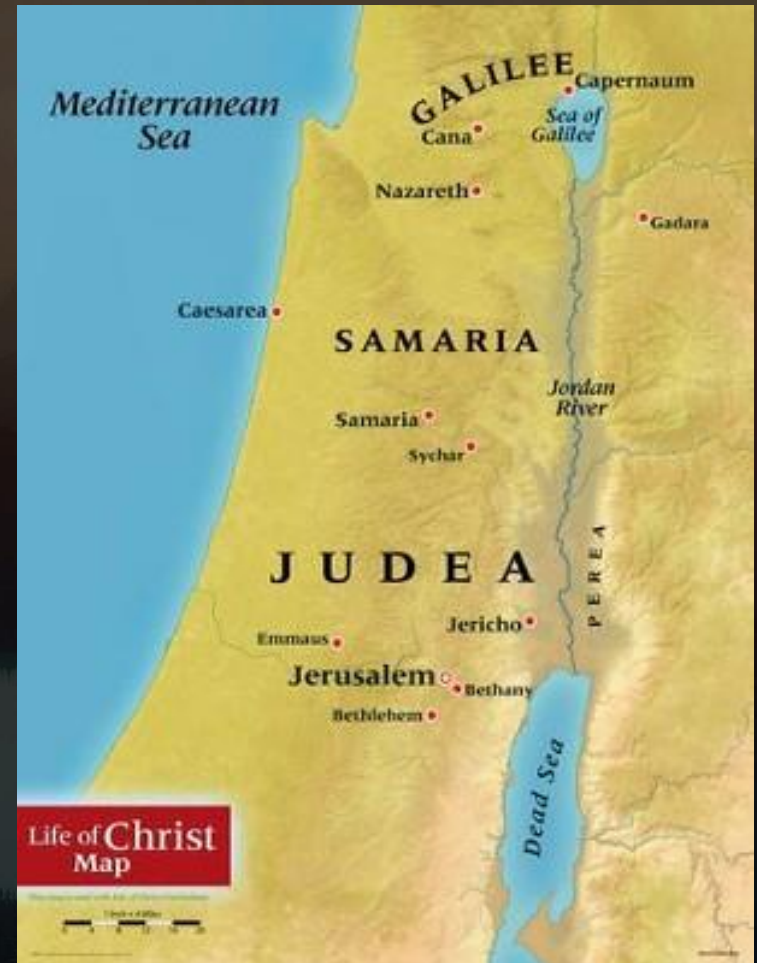




In a world that divides



## Three things we can learn from Jesus in this encounter


1. A willingness to meet with and be with people who are different.
