Luke 10

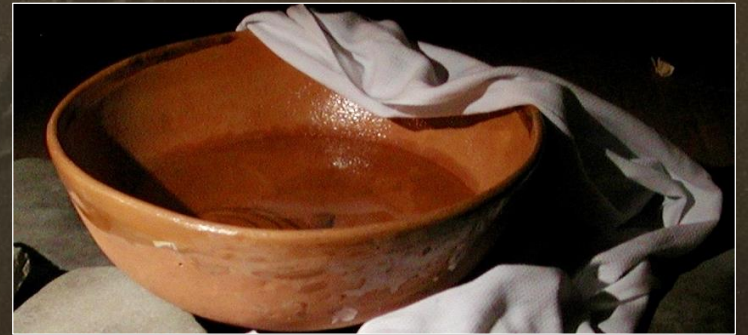
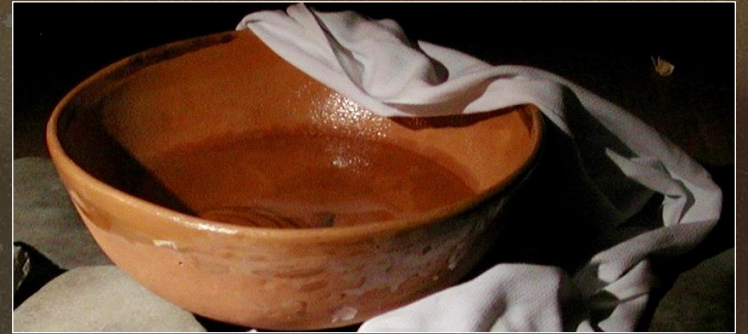


Now that I, your Lord and Teacher,




I have set you an example that you
