

## WALKING

Recently I shared a devotion by Oswald Chambers with the residents of Eberhardt Village. The title was "Getting into God's Stride." The first couple of sentences say this: "The true test of a person's spiritual life and character is not what he does in the extraordinary moments of life, but what he does during the ordinary times when there is nothing tremendous or exciting happening. A person's worth is revealed in his attitude toward the ordinary things of life when he is not under the spotlight." This devotion talks about staying in stride with God and that it can be difficult at times.

As I thought about walking with God there were several things that came to mind for me. When you walk with someone you are going in the same direction. You can't walk with someone and go the opposite direction; before long you will lose sight of them. If you walk too far ahead or lag behind, it becomes difficult to hear them and understand what they are saying. Walking

with God should be much like a walk you take with your spouse or a good friend. It is time spent in conversation, sharing with each other, listening and learning to know each other in a more intimate way. When you are walking with someone, your focus is usually on the person you are with. Walking with God is not just your prayer time. It should be a daily commitment and lifestyle that is part of our journey on this earth. If you want to know the answers to the difficult things you face each day, walk with God. If you want to know your purpose or direction in life, walk with God.

Chambers states in the devotion that "Getting into God's stride means nothing less than oneness with God." A familiar verse reminds us that walking with God is something that we are called to do. Micah 6: 8 says "He has showed you, O man, what is good, and what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."


