The NIV translation of the Bible is still the top-selling Bible in 2020. According to Evangelical Christian Publishers Association... The NIV ranks #1 as it did in 2011. The King James version is 2nd with the New Living Translation moving up to 3rd from 4th in The English Standard version moved from 5th to 4th, while the New King James version fell from 3rd to 5th. The rest of the top 10 in 2020 are the Christian Standard Bible, Reina Valera, New International Readers Version, The Message, and the New American Standard Bible.

Arthur Community Blood Drive

An American Red Cross blood drive will be held in the Arthur community on Thursday, January 7, from 1-6 pm at the Arthur United Methodist Church fellowship hall. The Red Cross is still in need of blood during this time and the following safety precautions will be followed during this drive. Everyone will be required to wear a mask, temperatures will be taken before donors enter the room, no additional guests or children will be able to enter, and the Red Cross is asking all donors to call and/or register this time instead of just walking in. Please do not come if you are not feeling well or have other symptoms. Walk-ins will not be turned away but a limited number of people will be allowed at each time. All donors at this time will also be able to be tested for a COVID-19 antibody through the Red Cross. One car accident victim can use as many as 100 units of blood. Be the lifeline patients need. Keeping Up




- Sherrill Shunk passed away this past Wednesday in Mattoon. The family is planning a private (family only) funeral. Keep Ray and the family in your prayers.
