Do you currently have a job? I am a pharmacy technician at Dicks Pharmacy in Arthur. I answer phone calls, work the register and count and process prescriptions.

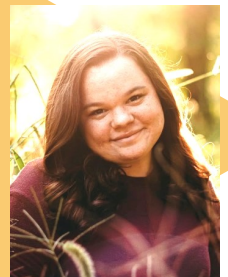
After graduation, I will be attending the U of I at Champaign-Urbana to pursue a degree in business.
