At first Joseph didn't always handle things in the best way.

We can relate!



Nothing good can come from this!

God can see future opportunities in the midst of our regrets



Are we going to just drown in our regrets of the past?

OR

Are we going to refocus our lives around the opportunities that God has for us in the future?



Satan is always looking for ways to disrupt, change, or deter your commitment to God and Jesus.

The LORD was with Joseph so that he prospered, and he lived in the house of his Egyptian master. When his master saw that the LORD was with him and that the LORD gave him success in everything he did, Joseph found favor in his eyes and became his attendant. Potiphar put him in charge of his household, and he entrusted to his care everything he owned.

Genesis 39:2-4

Temptations are dangerous when we ignore 3 things

- When we neglect our time with God
- When we are physically tired
- When we put ourselves in places that are not safe.

We often can't see the bigger picture that God sees!
