

God Is Faithful!

In Joshua 4 as the Israelites finally enter the Promised Land, the Lord told Joshua to take twelve stones (one for each tribe) and build a memorial to remember God's faithfulness in fulfilling His promises.
In Joshua 4:6 the Lord says, "In the future, when your children ask you, What do these stones mean?' Tell them..." He goes on to say that these stones are to be a memorial to the people of Israel forever.

This memorial fountain is meant to be a reminder of God's faithfulness. Our hope and prayer is that it causes us to remember the goodness of God and the faithfulness of Jesus to this church family through the past and into the future. May it remind us of Lamentations 3:22-23 that says, "The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."

This fountain also reminds us of the words of Jesus in John 7:37-38 "Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink. Whoever believes in me, as Scripture has said, rivers of living water will flow from within them."

The AMC church family is so grateful for the many blessings the Lord has shown to us through the years. May this memorial fountain be a reminder for us that God is Faithful, just as those stones in Joshua 4 were a reminder.
