The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; his mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is your faithfulness. ~ *Lamentations 3:23*

Has there ever been a time in your life that you questioned whether the sun would come up in the morning? Or maybe if the sun would go down? I cannot recall a time that I questioned this. Have you ever questioned if Tuesday would be after Monday, or if July would come after June? These seem like silly questions maybe. Time never changes. Never to be forsaken. God's love is described this way in many places of the Bible:

Deuteronomy 31:8 ~ "The Lord Himself goes before you and will be with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged."
John 15:9~ "I have loved you even as the Father has loved Me. Remain in My love."
Psalm 136 ~ "Give thanks to the God of gods. His love endures forever."

Think now of the people who have chosen to love you. When you celebrate; they are there. When you are sick or healing; they are there. When you need to talk; they are there. When you need guidance or advice; they are there. They choose to be there; day after day... for better and for worse. This is a beautiful thing to think about. Something even more beautiful is knowing that when our loved ones are gone, when people disappoint us, or when someone chooses to no longer love us; God's love will never fail. God's love is immeasurable. God's love is steadfast, and this is for all of eternity.
