In July of this year, I will embark on a two and a half week journey to Quito, Ecuador to serve on a mission through Global Encounters. This organization goes all over the world on a handful of missions throughout the year to places including Romania, Zimbabwe, Thailand, and Ecuador. This summer, I will go to Ecuador with approximately 15 other missionaries and we will host two separate camps for children in Quito. One week will be spent within the city working with the children, with the second week being spent on the coast. The camp consists of games, crafts, skits, stories, and relationship building skills. The goal of the mission is that the children will respond to the Gospel and will receive the Lord as their Savior. In December, the church body received a letter in mailboxes from me, regarding my trip, asking for financial support. With an extreme amount of gratitude and thanks, I can now say I am fully funded thanks to my amazing and supportive church family! I am incredibly thankful. Any donations I now receive will automatically go to the Global Encounters organization in order to help other missionaries fulfill their calling from the Lord. As I prepare mentally and physically for my mission, I ask for prayers that the Lord will keep me safe. Also pray that the words and actions I show will point the camp children to God.
