

"Standing Firm In Faith"

In Exodus 14 we read about the Israelites dramatic crossing of the Red Sea. Imagine all of the feelings and emotions that must have been present as the Israelites became trapped between the Sea and the approaching army of Pharaoh. What was Moses thinking? How were the Israelites responding in their conversations with each other? What did the Egyptian army think as the Red Sea parted and the Israelites began to walk through to the other side? In that situation the Israelites were stuck between a rock and a hard place. That's an expression that we often use for situations we find ourselves in, but it also describes the dilemma that the Israelites were faced with as well. With the Red Sea ahead and the Egyptian army behind, did they have faith that the Lord would deliver them?

With inflation, economic challenges, and cultural challenges recently, many people these days are finding themselves between a rock and a hard place. Undoubtedly, difficult times like these are when our faith is often tested. Maybe it's a mortgage that is hard to pay. Maybe it's a job that has been lost. Maybe it's the cultural shift in our country.

Maybe it's stress within your family. Each of us has a different challenge we must face. But the Lord knows what that challenge is for you.

I love the encouragement of Moses in verse 13 of Exodus 14. He says to the Israelites, "Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today." The next day Moses went out and stretched his hand over the sea and it says, "All night the Lord drove the sea back with a strong east wind and turned it into dry land. The waters were divided, and the Israelites went through the sea on dry ground, with a wall of water on their right and on their left."

I don't know what you're facing right now, but I hope that your faith in God will stand strong in both your times of blessing and your times of trial. If God can part the Red Sea to deliver his people, then there is a way for you to be delivered from your situation or circumstance as well. God wants us to do our part in putting forth the effort, but as Moses would say; don't be afraid, take it to the Lord in prayer, stand firm in your faith, and watch and wait for the Lord's deliverance. When we place our trust in God, there is hope!
